It is not our intent to get a band to directly increase our membership. We are an anime convention. We are here to serve anime fans with the best possible convention. We extend beyond the anime genre to serve anime fans' other interests beyond pure anime (video). Therefore, because many anime fans are a fan of Japanese music, cosplay, comics, games, etc... we have events around these genres which are not strictly anime (video). I think it is safe to say that more anime fans are fans of the music from anime than non-anime Japanese music. Therefore that is what gets priority when we can make that happen. We have had Japanese band before that had nothing to do with anime, but that was largely because we didn't have better aligned options.

We wish to attract as many anime fans as possible. People who are not fans of anime, but are fans of the adjacent genres are welcome, but they are not our primary customer.

If we were for-profit (as some of the other conventions mentioned) we would likely be more included to stray from this path in seek of the mighty dollar. As a non-profit, we can stick to our mission.

That being said, it is highly likely we will have bands in the future without any anime ties.
