Stacey, I'll count your votes, but please listen to my explanation as to why your games weren't on the initial list.

The Broken Bond and Rise of the Ninja are two games for the 360, and I do not want a repeat of what happened last year when all of the Wii consoles that I was using to run ISP Brawl were taken up to the owner's room because it was running so late into the night and I wasn't finished with the tournament. The only way I can get those games into the wheel is that two or three things happening. One is that I run SF4 for the 360. The other is if I get a PS3 for Tekken 5 DR and still have some leftover cash for the 360. It could be possible that I could get both consoles, but right now things are not looking too good for me to have the budget necessary to do all of the things that I want to do to run said games. The third and final thing is if someone would be willing to donate their 360 long enough to allow those games to run.

Ultimate Ninja 4, on the other hand, has two distinct advantages. One is that it is for the PS2. This means that I could carry a 2 pound console around plus a PS3 box and I don't have to worry about when the owner of the 360 that I am using for my tournament wants their system back.

The other is that I'm buying this game anyways! It would be a waste of time to save up money to buy two games that I will probably never play because I don't have a 360.

On to the other questions:

El_Minigame: It would be about one or two hours normally, however, last year was a learning experience because I was having a hard time tracking down players and getting them settled

down enough to have a match. I'm probably going to shoot myself in the foot and say about three hours with enough commitments.

There is also a reason why I'm limiting this to five games. I think that I don't have the time to run a ten game wheel, plain and simple, and it would gunk up the matches.

On that, I would like to say that this year's AF will be different from last year. For any game I run this year, if you sign up for a game and you don't show, instant DQ. It won't matter if it is a paid game(prizes will be planned for SF4 for sure) or a free tournament. It will be your responsibility for you to show up on time to my tournaments if you signed up for it. This is your first and only warning.
